You may know about our Child Internet Sex Offender Investigations program, called "Cheezo". The program has two components – prevention and undercover investigations. We have been very successful in arresting predators who seek out children through the Internet and/or their cell phones. We have arrested over 400 sex offenders, including 98 this year alone. This proactive component of the program is funded through the county.

What you might not know is that our Cheezo Educational Program is not funded. The Cheezo Internet and Cell Phone Safety Program is funded through private donations to the District Attorney's 501(c)(3) non profit Community Partnership." The unique aspect of this non-profit is all monies go toward the educational program.

The Cheezo Educational Program has averaged 120 Internet Safety presentations a year to children and adults. We also participate in community events such as West Metro's Fire Muster, the DA's Consumer Safety Fair, National Night Out, Summerset, and many local festivals. We go where parents and kids go.
